## A BILL

for A JOINT RESOLUTION ratifying a proposed amendment to the 1 Constitution of the United States of America relative to 2 equal rights for men and women. 3 WHEREAS, the Ninety-Second Congress of the United 4 States of America at its Second Session, in both houses, 5 by a constitutional majority of two-thirds thereof, 6 adopted the following proposal to amend the Constitution 7 of the United States of America in the following words, 8 to-wit; 9 "JOINT RESOLUTION 10 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 11 UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED (two-thirds 12 of each House concurring therein), That 13 The following article is proposed as an amendment to 14 the Constitution of the United States, which shall be 15 valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitu-16 tion when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of 17

- the several States within seven years from the date of its 1 submission by the Congress: 2
- "Article 3
- Equality of rights under the law shall "Section 1. 4 not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any
- State on account of sex. 6
- The Congress shall have the power to "Sec. 2. 7
- enforce, by appropriate legislation, the provisions of 8
- this article. 9
- This amendment shall take effect two years "Sec. 3. 10
- after the date of ratification." 11
- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING, 12
- a majority of all the members of the two houses, voting 13
- separately, concurring therein: 14
- That the above proposed amendment to the 15
- Constitution of the United States of America 'is ratified 16
- by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming. 17
- Section 2. That certified copies of this Resolution 18
- be forwarded by the Governor of Wyoming to the Administra-19
- tor of General Services, Washington, D.C., and the Presi-20
- dent of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-21
- sentatives of the Congress of the United States. 22
