Bought a couple of records for you - I hope you don't have them. G. Miller's "Along the Santa Fe Trail" and "Rhapsody in Blue". Harry James "Flight of the Bumble Bee" and "Carnival of Venice". I'll bring them when I come home. I gotta bring you something being unable to

get any films that you wanted me to get for you.

How's the motion picture situation coming along? movie czar. You must have a very high position of utmost importance. Well maybe you can order some good musicals for the week when we get there. Since the price went up to 10¢ I thought you'd have better pictures. Last week's "Elephant Boy" is an old picture. I remember I saw it five or six years ago. Or was it three or four?

If you want anything that I can get for you just write and say so. I'll be coming home soon so this Saturday is probably the last time I'll be able to go to town.

The boss has some Italian prisoners of war working for him picking potatoes. They all seem happy and healthy. They can't speak English & the guard can't speak Italian so there's a sort of sign language around here. They get paid

10¢ a sack but from what I hear
all but 90¢ goes to the government and
the PW just gets 90¢ a day for his work
in script not cash.

Well I'll be closing now
Andy keep yourself healthy and strong
so I can see a rosy checked, bursting
with energy fellow when I greet you.
