We have found it impossible to get a definite answer from the committee before this. Now they decide to give no more public hearings on either side of the suffrage question. If you were here, I think a private hearing might be arranged.

Last night I telegraphed you, hoping if the date you named sometime since were still free that we could have a public meeting to enlighten the Albanians and some of our delegates who are not posted on woman suffrage up to date.

In case you can come could not arrange to be here for the day Tuesday so as to attend the convention in the morning and possibly appear before the committee in the afternoon? The public meeting would be in the evening.

We feel that great consequences hang on the result in New York state this year.
