

An Easterner by birth, she lived in China for 14 years and has been twice around the globe. Now she calls Wyoming "home" and the adoption has been mutual. She likes the open spaces "where there is room for the spirit". Audiences admire her warm personality on the lecture platform, her delightful sense of humor, and illuminating narration. It is readily understandable that Mildred Capron is universally acknowledged today as a top-ranking film-lecturer and photographer and is included in "Who's Who of American Women."
