Articles of Agreement between J. S. & D. T.
Casement & Sidney Dillon

1st. The above parties agree to do all the work on the Union Pacific Rail Road under the firm of J. S. & D. T. Casement.

2nd. That J. S. & D. T. Casement are to have three-fourths ($3/4$) of the net profits arising there from and Sidney Dillon one fourth ($1/4$)

3rd. The parties are to pay into the capitol stock of the concern an amount sufficient to prosecute the work and in proportion to their relative interests as specified on the 2nd article of this agreement.

4th. None of the above parties shall have a salarie for any services rendered under the above agreement.
